

NATIONAL UNIVERSITY CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS 2025

1. The National University Championships (from now on referred to as CNU) are organized by the Italian Federation of University Sports (FederCUSI) in collaboration with University Sports Centers (CUS) and National Sports Federations (FSN);
2. The 2025 Spring CNU will be held in May in the Marche region, organized by the University of Ancona and FederCUSI. The sports disciplines admitted, including optional sports, will be indicated, with a specific general regulation, by FederCUSI, including the dates, times, and competition regulations for each sport (for reference, see the link to the previous edition's regulations):

3. The CNU are competitions reserved for students aged between 18 and 28 years old (born between January 1, 1997, and December 31, 2007) and enrolled in a course of study (bachelor's degree, master's degree, single-cycle degree, specialization diploma, doctoral program, first and second level master's), as provided for in Article 3 of DM 22/10/2004, n. 270, at the University of Rome Tor Vergata;
4. Graduates in the calendar year of the National University Championships (2025) may also participate;
5. Registration for the CNU is **free**, with only a membership fee of €10.00 (online service via the indicated link) required for insurance coverage. This is necessary for participation in training camps and/or training sessions organized by the CUS to select the athletes who will take part in the championships;

6. Students/athletes who believe they have a high-level sports CV can submit their application by completing the following form:

7. Applying does not guarantee participation in the CNU; it allows the athlete to be considered for selection as provided in point 9;
8. Athletes participating in the CNU will receive a certificate of participation, which can be useful in the evaluation of their sports career for access to benefits provided by the dual career athlete/student program (30% university fee exemption; reduced mandatory attendance; up to 6 ECTS credits);

9. **To participate in the training camps and/or training sessions** organized by the CUS for athlete selection for the CNU, the following requirements must be met:
Completion of membership registration (insurance coverage) as indicated above;
 - a) Possession of a valid medical certificate for competitive sports to be submitted to the

- b) Possession of a clearance issued by the Cus Tor Vergata office following administrative verification of the submitted documentation.

10. Selected athletes must submit the following documents **by February 10, 2025, for teams, and by April 30, 2025, for individual sports**, to the email address cnu@cusromatorvergata.it:

- a. Enrollment or attendance certificate issued by the university;
- b. Proof of registration fee payment or an authenticated copy from the affiliated CUS;
- c. Proof of university enrollment or an authenticated copy from the affiliated CUS;
- d. Self-certification proving university enrollment, provided it is downloaded from the web and clearly and unambiguously contains the personal data, matriculation number, faculty of affiliation, and paid tuition for the current year;
- e. Graduates must submit their degree certificate;
- f. Clearance for participation in the CNU issued by the affiliated club.

11. The criteria for selecting athletes to represent the University at the CNU are:

- a. Evaluation of previous sports results, particularly those from the last sports season;
- b. Technical/tactical evaluation by the head coach of the specific sport, where explicitly required;
- c. Number of attendances at training sessions organized by the CUS.

12. Athletes who reach the podium will be reimbursed for travel and accommodation costs (*accommodation based on the competition calendar and subject to CUS approval, up to a maximum of €50 per night*). Expenses must be documented with **original** receipts to be submitted to the CUS office;

13. Selected athletes for the CNU will be supervised in competition exclusively by CUS Coaches/Trainers (*if indicated*);

14. Those registered for the CNU selections **must** participate in all activities organized by the CUS, particularly the following: CNU presentation (*November*); CUS end-of-year party (*December*); presentation of CNU athletes with greetings in the presence of the Rector (*March*); farewell dinner for CNU athletes (*May*); Top Players end-of-sports-season party (*late May*).
